

Instructions for 2008 British Eighth Drumline Auditions/Camp:

- Everyone is required to have a practice pad and snare sticks at camp. If you intend to play snare, you should have Vic Firth Ralph Hardiman sticks. Other sections may have any type of drumstick, for practice only.
- Please memorize the exercises BEFORE band camp for the instrument you intend to audition on. For Bass Drums and Cymbals, please learn the entire parts as unison. We will work on the split parts after the line is set and you are assigned a position.
- Please pay attention to the stick height guide and prepare the warm-ups at all dynamic levels according to the guide.
- Wednesday of camp will be committed to helping everyone understand and correctly execute the warm-ups. Some of you will be assigned an instrument that night, and others who are considered “probationary” for their instrument will have until the next morning to better prepare. The line will be set permanently during the Thursday morning rehearsal.
