



Jessie Longhurst Rotary Service Award

Presented by the Rotary Club of Albion
to an Albion College student or student group

The Jessie Longhurst Rotary Service Award is presented annually to an Albion College student or student group who has demonstrated exceptional innovation, motivation and involvement in service to the Albion community. Jessie, an Albion College student who died in a car accident in April of 2005, devoted her life to improving the lives of others. Her legacy of leadership through service inspired this award.

Award Criteria

This award recognizes an individual or group who has exhibited a commitment to others without regard for personal gain, and is presented in recognition of past efforts and in hopes of inspiring others to become engaged in the larger community. The service must have been performed without pay and must be beyond the scope of a regular class assignment.

Award Selection

This award is sponsored by the Rotary Club of Albion and the process is facilitated by the Sleight Servant Leadership Program at Albion College. The selection team will consist of a Sleight Servant Leadership Program staff member, a member of the Rotary Club of Albion, a member/representative of the Longhurst family, an Albion College student, and an Albion College faculty member. The award will be announced at the annual Leadership Recognition Dessert on the evening of April 21, 2009. All nominees will be invited to attend the dessert. A plaque honoring each year's recipients hangs in the Kellogg Center on the Albion College campus.
