The selection team will consist of a Sleight Servant Leadership Program staff member, a member of the faculty, and a member of the first year, sophomore and junior classes. The award will be announced at the annual Leadership Recognition Dessert on the evening of April 21, 2009. All nominees will be invited to attend the dessert.
