Albion College expects that 6 of the 8 required units will be completed at Albion College. Transfer students may consult with the Albion College Biology Department to apply additional Biology transfer credit.

Students transferring from two-year institutions may present a maximum of 20 units (80 credit hours) to transfer towards their Bachelor's Degree. Coursework assigned a passing grade equal to or above 2.0 (C or better) on a 4.0 scale may be recognized in transfer. Courses in which a grade of CR (credit) was earned are not transferrable.
