Using Engage

Engage is your one-stop shop for all things relating to student organizations!

Here you will:

- Register and re-register your organization each semester
- Submit budget requests
- Maintain a roster of active members
- Submit Events
 - Get your access code for Check-in app



Register vs. Re-register

Register

- Only for organizations that have never registered with our office before
 - Or those that have been deactivated for a full year or more (two semesters)
- Registering as a student organization gets you special access to things like SAF funds, posting fliers, print credit, posting on Albion Today, a personal Engage page just for your organization, and more!

Re-registering

- Only for organizations that have been registered before
- Updating leadership information, name changes, etc.

Walk-throughs

- Register/re-register
- Posting an event on Engage
 - RSVPs, Post-event questions
- Finding your access code
- How to use Check-in
 - Access code
 - "Guest" login for those that don't have their event pass on them
- Managing your organization page
 - Adding advisor(s)
 - Adding leadership
 - Maintaining roster of active members
