## YOUR ALBION 1 CARD



Your student ID - "Albion 1 Card" helps with a number of things on campus. This will help you access your room and dining venues,



## WI-FI



Every residential building has wifi available in rooms and lounges. For more information about accessing network and device capabilities, scan this QR code.



## NEIGHBORS



We recommend keeping your door open in the first few weeks, and practice your hallmates' names so you can greet them around campus.



## PARKING



Campus Safety is located across from Seaton Hall and coordinates parking on campus. Students who have purchased a parking pass will receive a designated parking lot assignment and a car decal.



## LAUNDRY

Laundry facilities are located in each residential building, and are free for student use.



## FACILITIES

## POST OFFICE
