

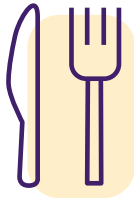


MOVE-IN CHECKLIST

MAKING DAY 1 A SUCCESS

☐ Meal Plans

Students are assigned one of three meal plans: 15, 18, or 21 Block Plans, which can work to “swipe” at a number of places across campus. If you have dietary restrictions, be sure to email dining@albion.edu to set up a meeting with the College dietitian.



☐ Dining Dollars

Residential meal plans come with Dining Dollars that can be used in place of cash at on campus dining venues.



☐ Albion 1 Card

Your student ID - “Albion 1 Card” helps with a number of things on campus. This will help you access your room and dining venues.



☐ Brit Bucks

Students and family can also add ‘Brit Bucks’ to an Albion1Card to be used in select restaurants and stores in town and on campus.

Every residential building has wifi available in rooms and lounges. For more information about accessing network and device capabilities, scan this QR code.

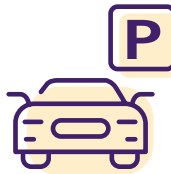


☐ Neighbors

☐ Parking

Campus Safety is located across from Seaton Hall and coordinates parking on campus. Students who have purchased a parking pass will receive a designated parking lot assignment and a car decal.



☐ Laundry

Laundry facilities are located in each residential building, and are free for student use.



☐ Facilities

Our maintenance and grounds teams are dedicated to your safety and work hard to make campus spaces look and feel great. You will receive a Room Condition Inventory form the first week of classes for you to document any fixtures not working properly in your room.



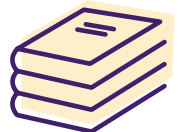
☐ Post Office
